(a) & (b): As per the information received from State Government of Odisha efforts have been made by them to provide employment opportunities to migrant workers in their home districts by providing 150 days of work in a year under MGNREGS. The cost of the additional 50 days work is being borne by the State Government. The National Institute of Rural Development (NIRD), Hyderabad has also been entrusted with conducting a study in migration prone areas of Odisha including Ganjam district, to determine the reasons for migration and suggest measures for mitigation of problems associated with the same.
