- (c) whether the Union Government has received certain demands from various State Governments including the State Government of Rajasthan for declaration of Areas/Regions as Tribal Region or to extend the Scheduled Areas/Regions; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the action taken by the Government thereon?

- (c) & (d): The Governments of Himachal Pradesh, Kerala and Rajasthan had submitted proposals for extension/declaration of Scheduled Areas in the respective States. The proposals have been examined.
