- (a) and (b) The High Level Committee (HLC) headed by Shri T.S.R. Subramanian has submitted its report with 55 major recommendations, which includes:
- Enacting a new umbrella Environment Law- Environment Law (Management) Act (ELMA) to provide for setting up of National Environment Management Authority(NEMA) and State Environment Management Authority(SEMA).
- Setting up of a national level institute on Environment.
- NEMA/SEMA to develop systems for effective monitoring of compliances.
- $\hat{a}$ €¢ NEMA/SEMA to make recommendations to the Ministry on environment clearances.
- A National level electronic database to be developed for environment and forest parameters.
- Integration of various clearances.
- Integration of provisions of Water and Air act in the new law and subsequent sub-subsumation of CPCB and SPCB in NEMA and SEMA respectively, and others.
- (c) to (e) In order to prepare a broad framework based on the recommendations of HLC, the Ministry has appointed a Technical Consultant who has submitted the Inception Report and Gap Assessment Report which is to be followed by a final report expected in November 2015. A final decision on the recommendation of High Level Committee will be taken thereafter and after completing stakeholder consultations.

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
