Cement Corporation of India Limited (CCI) is a sick BiFR referred company, It has got 3 operating units and 7 non-operating units. As per the revival scheme approved by the BIFR/Govt., 6 of its non-operating units have been closed and 3 operating units are under modernisation. In view of the manpower requirement for 3 operating units/corporate office, the sanctioned strength is to be determined on the basis of finalisation of the manpower study undertaken by the Administrative Staff College of India, Hyderabad. Filling in the vacancies on compassionate grounds depends upon

finalised sanctioned strength.
