(a) to (b): There is no new proposal to accord approval for 'separate security force'. However, the Government during 2011-2014 has approved creation of 10 Special India Reserve Battalions (SIRBs) in 6 LWE affected States namely, Bihar (02), Chhattisgarh (02), Jharkhand (01), Madhya Pradesh (01), Odisha (03) and West Bengal (01) to carry out developmental works like, construction of roads, schools, primary health care, etc. Besides, 1 unraised IR Bn. in Jharkhand has also been converted into SIRB.
