Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is shortage of Government houses for Postal, Department of Telecommunications and Information Technology employees;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the representations/complaints received, if any, in this regard;
- (c) whether any action has been taken by the Government thereon; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) & (b) No, Madam. There is no shortage of government houses for the employees of Department of Posts. The allotment of staff quarters is an ongoing and continuous process and it is undertaken as and where the quarter falls vacant.

As far as the Department of Telecommunications and Department of Electronics and Information Technology are concerned, the employees of these two Departments are covered under the General Pool Residential Accommodation system of the Directorate of Estates and no separate quota has been identified for them.
