Will the Minister of DEVELOPMENT OF NORTH EASTERN REGION be pleased to state:

- a) The number of projects which received external financial aid from the Asian Development Bank and the World Bank for development of the North Eastern States during the last three years and current year, year-wise and state-wise; and
b) The total funds received during the said period, State-wise and project wise and the present status of physical and financial achievement of such projects ?

Answer

a) The projects which received external financial aid from the Asian Development Bank and the World Bank for development of the North Eastern States, which were implemented through the Ministry of DoNER in the last three years and current year are as follows –

(i) The Asian Development Bank(ADB) assisted North Eastern State Roads Investment Programme (NESRIP) for construction/upgradation of roads in 6 (six) North Eastern States was approved by Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) on 19th May, 2011 at an estimated cost of Rs.1353.83 crore. The ADB is providing loan assistance of upto US \$ 200 million (Rs. 908.0 Crore approx.)in two tranches. In 2012-13, loan assistance for 5 (five) road projects became effective for construction/upgradation of 197. 30 Kms. in the States of Assam, Meghalaya and Sikkim. Similarly, in 2014 -15, Tranche II of the loan 5 (five) roads projects became effective for development of 236.125 Kms. roads in the States of Assam, Manipur, Mizoram and Tripura. Reimbursement mode of disbursement is being followed.

(ii) World Bank Assisted North East Rural Livelihood Project (NERLP) became effective from March, 2012 for a period of five years. It is a multi-state rural livelihood project being implemented in two districts each of Mizoram, Nagaland, Sikkim and in five districts (after reorganization of the two original project districts) of Tripura. The project will cover 62 blocks and 1645 villages. The total project cost stands at Rs. 683.2 Crore.

(b) The total funds received by the States during the said period, State-wise and project wise and the present status of physical and financial achievement of NESRIP and NERLP are as follows –
