(a) to (c): Delhi Nurses Union had given a notice to go on strike protesting against the recruitment process of Staff Nurses.

Director General of Health Services heard the grievances of Nurses Union on 5th February, 2015. It was decided in the meeting to withhold the recruitment process for filling up the post of staff nurse and to take up the matter with DoPT & UP SC for revising eligibility criteria for recruitment of nurses.
