- (b) if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b) Drinking water supply is State subject. However for drinking water supply in rural areas, under National Rural Drinking Water Programme, the Government provides financial and technical assistance to States to supplement their efforts to provide adequate safe drinking water to the rural population. States have been delegated the powers to select, approve and implement the drinking water supply projects/schemes. To ensure sustainability of functioning of rural water supply schemes, both new & old which includes non-functional schemes also, the States have to adopt improved Operation & Maintenance (O&M) methods for their better working and to repair damaged / non-functional Drinking Water Supply Schemes including piped water supply schemesto make sustainable for household tap connection. For this O&M, up to 15% of funds under NRDWPallocated by this Ministryto the States can be utilized.
