- (b) & (c) A proposal at an estimated cost of Rs.2500 crores has been prepared for provision of drinking water supply to about 1500 habitations across 12 districts of North Karnataka where the World Bank assisted "Jalnirmal" project has been implemented to address the water quality problem. As reported by the State Government of Karnataka the proposal has been submitted to the State Finance Department of Government of Karnataka for clearance. A period of 5 years has been projected to implement this project.
