Will the Minister of DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the amount earmarked/allocated for Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM) and Drinking Water Scheme (DWS) during 2014-2015, State/UT-wise;
- (b) whether the Government proposes to increase the allocated amount under SBM and DWS in 2015-16, if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise:
- (c) whether the Government has made surveys to assess the sanitation requirements in the rural areas; and
- (d) if so, the details of the assessment made in this regard, State-wise?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF DRINKING WATER & SANITATION (SHRI RAM KRIPAL YADAV)

- (a) Since Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) is demand driven scheme, hence no state-wise allocation made. However State/UT-wise, central share released under SBM(G) and National Rural Drinking Water Programme(NRDWP) during 2014-2015 is at Annexure-1.
- (b) During the current Financial Year 2015-16 an amount of Rs. 2611 crores has been allocated under NRDWP and Rs. 2625 crores under SBM(G). Additional funds have been sought under Supplementary Demands.
- (c) and (d) Government of India had in 2012 requested all States/UTs to carry out Baseline surveys, which will provide sanitation status of panchayats. Baseline Survey has been completed in 248709 Gram Panchayats of 31 States/UTs as reported by the States/UTs through Online Monitoring System maintained by the Ministry. As on 27.7.2015, 45.87% rural households have toilets. State/UT wise details is at Annexure 2.
