Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to extend National Highway No.204 to Nagpur;
- (b) if so, the details thereof including the works sanctioned and agencies involved in the project;
- (c) the funds allocated/released/utilized for this purpose; and
- (d) the steps taken by the Government for early completion of the project?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI KRISHANPAL GURJAR)

- (a) National Highway No.204 which has been renumbered as National Highway No.166 is already extended up to Nagpur by National Highway No. 361.
- (b) So far no work has been sanctioned for improving the said stretch of NH-361 and as such no agency has been fixed.
- (c) The funds are not allocated National Highway wise, but a total allocation of Rs 22.00 cr has been given to Maharashtra State and an expenditure of Rs. 21.9 cr has already been incurred.
