- (c) whether any special assistance is being provided to the entrepreneurs of ethnic textile industries of the NE region; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken to showcase ethnic textile goods from the NE region in International trade expos?

Answer

(a) to (d): For overall development of textile sector in the entire North Eastern Region(NER), the Government is implementing North Eastern Region Textile Promotion Scheme (NERTPS), in addition to benefits available in general schemes of the Ministry of Textiles.

The objective of projects of market promotion of NERTPS is to increase the handloom fabric production by way of establishing market linkages and better access to domestic and export markets so that weavers are able to get continuous employment and improve their living standards.

The Government of India has sanctioned 7 marketing events in the year 2013-14 and released an amount of Rs.132.75 lakhs. During the year 2014-15, total 21 events have been sanctioned and Rs.381.83 lakh has been released for promoting and showcasing the products of the region.
