## Will the Minister of TEXTILES be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Union Government has ever attempted to ascertain the number of traditional handloom centres in various States including Gujarat;

(b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise;

(c) the number of persons who are dependent upon these centres directly or indirectly; and

(d) the various measures being taken by the Union Government for socio-economic upliftment of these centres and those engaged in this industry by way of extending financial and technological support to them?

## Answer

(a) to (c): As per Third All India Handloom Census (2009-10), there were 43,31,876 handloom weavers and allied workers across the country including the state of Gujarat. State-wise details are given in Annexure-I.

1. National Handloom Development Programme

2. Handloom Weavers Comprehensive Welfare Scheme

3. Yarn Supply Scheme

4. Comprehensive Handloom Cluster Development Scheme
