- (a) & (b) The proposal for restructuring of Brahmaputra Board into North East & Brahmaputra River Rejuvenation Authority (NEBRRA) is under consultation with the concerned State Governments and Central Government Ministries. It is proposed that the Authority shall have the requisite powers which may be necessary or expedient for the purpose of performing its functions for effective Management & Development of Water Resources in the North East & Brahmaputra Basin.
- (c) The States covered/ to be covered in the Authority are Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Sikkim, Tripura and West Bengal.
