(a) to (e)A proposal for National Hydrology Project with the objective of establishing and upgrading Hydro-meteorological network in all the river basins; bringing the entire hydro-meteorological data on a standardised central database for easy storage, validation and dissemination; development of Decision Support Systems for flood forecasting, reservoir operations, water resources planning & management, conjunctive use etc. following a river basin approach; and enhancing capacity of the States and increasing collaboration between Centre & States and amongst the States themselves, has been submitted for approval of the Expenditure Finance Committee. The project is proposed to be implemented at a cost of Rs 3640 crore with partial World Bank's assistance over a period of eight years.
