STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (c) OF STARRED QUESTION NO. 249 TO BE ANSWERED IN THE LOK SABHA ON 24.07.2014 REGARDING POWER SUPPLY TO STATES FROM CENTRAL POOL.

- (a) :The total generation from Central Generating Stations (CGS) in the country during the current year (up to 30th June, 2014) was 102932.34 Million Units (MU). State/UT-wise details of power allocated from Central Generating Stations to various States/UTs, as on 30.06.2014, are given at Annex-I.
- (b): The guidelines for determining allocation of share / quota of States/UTs in Central Generating Stations are at Annex-II.
- (c) :Presently, there is no proposal for enhancing the share/quota of various States/UTs, including that of Karnataka, from the Central Pool. At any point of time, the entire unallocated power of Central Generating Stations remains allocated to the various States/UTs and any enhancement in allocation of any State/UT would be feasible only by way of equivalent reduction in the allocation of some other State/UT.
