- (a) As per the information received from various National Child Labour Project (NCLP) District Societies, at present, 4196 NCLP Special Training Centres (STCs) are operational. The State-wise details are at Annexure-I.
- (b) The number of children mainstreamed under National Child Labour Project (NCLP) Scheme by the Special Training Centres (STCs) running under NCLP District Project Societies during the last three years, State-wise is at Annexure-II.
- (c) For the current financial year 2015-16 under NCLP Scheme, the target for mainstreaming of children to formal system of education under NCLP is 45000. Action is being taken for a better monitoring system of scheme for more effective implementation.
