- (a)&(b): The National Small Industries Corporation Limited (NSIC), a Central PSE under the administrative control of this Ministry provides raw material assistance to MSMEs at competitive rates with good quality to enhance their competitive capacity. The raw materials which are made available to MSMEs include iron, steel, aluminium paraffin wax, coal, polymer products, copper, zinc, pipes, tubes, etc.
- (c): During the financial year 2014-15, NSIC facilitated 6540 units by providing them raw materials.
- (d)&(e): New raw materials are identified from time to time based on the market demand.
