(a) & (b): National Food Security Mission (NFSM) is implemented in 28 states of the country including Maharashtra during 2014-15. NFSM consists of five components i.e. NFSM-Rice, NFSM-Wheat, NFSM-Pulses, NFSM-Coarse cereals and NFSM- Commercial Crops and all five components are under implementation since 2014-15 in Maharashtra. The amount allocated and released under NFSM during 2014-15 and 2015-16 (till date) is given as under:-

Coarse cereals	248.95	201.95
