- (a) whether the Government proposes to allow Cairn-Oil and Natural Gas Corporation Limited (ONGC) consortium to establish export gas pipeline and additional distribution centre for sale of gas in Gujarat and if so, the details thereof; and
- (b) whether the State Government has permitted the said consortium to export gas to other States and if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b): Cairn India Limited (CAIRN) along with Oil & Natural Gas Corporation Limited (ONGC) and Government of India are parties to a Production Sharing Contract (PSC) with respect to the exploration block RJ-ON-90/1 (RJ Block) located in the State of Rajasthan. Cairn on behalf of the Joint Venture has submitted a proposal to the Petroleum & Natural Gas Regulatory Board (PNGRB) for establishing tie-in connectivity from RDG Terminal at Gudamalani, Barmer, in the State of Rajasthan to the GSPL's Palanpur Terminal in Gujarat under the provisions for tie-in connectivity as per the PNGRB Regulations. Board will decide the matter as per provisions of the Act/Regulations.
