(a) & (b) Yes Sir, a proposal for development of an all-weather, multi-purpose, deep-water, mechanized, greenfield port at Vizhinjam was submitted by M/s Vizhinjam International Seaport Limited, a fully owned Company of the Government of Kerala

(c) The proposal was appraised by the Expert Appraisal Committee and recommended for grant of Environmental and Coastal Regulation Zone Clearance. Accordingly, the clearance was issued on 3.1.2014.
