- (a) whether 47 countries have already submitted Intended Nationally Determined Contributions (INDCs) as part of the decision during CoP 19 in Warsaw to UNFCCC Secretariat;
- (b) whether the process of formulation of INDCs has been completed by India;
- (c) if so, the details thereof, including the key proposals envisaged under the INDCs; and
- (d) whether the Government has held any consultations with the States and other stakeholders in the formulation of INDCs and if so, the details thereof?

- (a) 50 Countries including 28 member states of European Union have submitted their Intended Nationally Determined Contributions (INDCs).
- (b) &(c) In light of the decision of Conference of Parties held in Lima wherein all Parties have been invited to communicate their intended nationally determined contributions well in advance of the twenty-first session of the Conference of Parties by 1stOctober 2015 in a manner that facilitates the clarity, transparency and understanding of the intended nationally determined contributions. Government of India has been undertaking an elaborate multi-stakeholder consultations for finalizing the INDCs, keeping in view of India's national circumstances.
- (d) Multi-stakeholder consultations has been carried out for formulation of INDCs; with various Ministries and departments and state government. Several interactive sessions have been held with NGOs and Industry associations to provide their suggestions on the matter.
