(a) & (b): The Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) has established a network of 639 Krishi Vigyan Kendras (KVK) at district level in the country for assessment and demonstration of technologies/ products to farmers as per the location specific requirements. As a part of its important activity, KVKs impart training to farmers to improve their farming skills. During the year 2013-14, 13.11 lakh farmers and farm women were trained in farming and allied enterprises. For the XIlth Plan, a target to train 75.00 lakh farmers and farm women has been proposed. For technological backstopping, these KVKs are supported by State Agricultural Universities, ICAR Institutes and Agricultural Colleges in order to conduct farmers' training and other technical programmes.
