Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has decided to extend the deadline for imparting Hindi training to nearly 31 lakh Central Government employees;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the Government has also extended this deadline three times earlier and if so, the details thereof along with the reasons therefor;
- (d) the funds allocated by the Government for promotion and development of Hindi in Central Government Ministries and departments during each of the last three years and the current year; and
- (e) the steps taken/being taken by the Government to encourage the Central Government employees to use Hindi in official work?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI KIREN RIJJU)

(a) to (c): Yes, Madam. The timeline for imparting training in Hindi to the employees of the Central Government offices located in all the regions (viz., 'A', 'B', and 'C') has been modified and set upto the end of year 2025. The timeline has been granted in view of the numbers of yet to be trained employees. Earlier, for employees of region 'A' and 'B' it was extended from year 1990 to 1997 and then to year 2000. For employees of region 'C' it was extended from year 1993 to year 2000 and then to year 2003. Again, for employees of all the regions viz., 'A', 'B' and 'C', it was extended upto the end of year 2005 which was further extended upto the end of year 2008 and then upto year 2015.

- (e). ENCOURAGEMENT SUCH AS PERSONEL PAY AND INCENTIVES FOR EMPLOYEES OF CENTRAL GOVT. FOR PASSING EXAMINATIONS OF HINDI TEACHING SCHEME
- 1. PERSONEL PAY: With a view to encouraging central govt. officers/employees an incentive/Personal pay equivalent to one increment for 12 months is given on Hindi Language, Hindi Typewriting and Hindi Stenography Examination.
- 2. CASH PRIZES: The following Cash prizes are given to employees who pass Hindi Training in "Prabodh" "Praveen" and "Pragya" Hindi Word Processing /Hindi Typing and Hindi Stenography examinations with good marks.:
