(a)to (b): The State and Institute-wise information regarding number of vacant posts of non- teaching staff in the Indian Institutes of Technology (IITs), Indian Institutes of Management (IIMs) and National Institutes of Technology (NITs) in the country may be seen at Annexure – I. The recruitment of non- teaching staff is a continuous process and the vacancies keep arising due to retirement, resignation and additional requirements on account of enhanced students' strength. The Institutes have initiated action to fill up the vacancies. The entire process of recruitment of non- teaching staff is conducted by the Institutes themselves without any intervention of the Ministry of HRD.
