- (a) & (b): Yes, Madam. Delhi Development Authority (DDA) has informed that as per order dated 31.10.2014 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, the allotment-cum-demand letters to 11,066 allottees of Sectors-28, 29, 30 & 34 (Pocket C1, C2, C3, C4, A1 & A2), Rohini have been issued by DDA.
- (c): DDA has informed that the delay in allotment of plots to the registrants of Rohini Residential Scheme-1981 is due to paucity of land, lack of infrastructural facilities, farmers' agitation and litigations related to the land in some parts.
- (d) & (e): No, Madam. In view of the reply given to part (c) above, no one has been held responsible for the delay.
