- (b): As per information made available by CBI, 4 cases are pending investigation relating to Naxal violence and 1 case under Official Secrets Act, 1923 as on 30.06.2015.
- (c): The information is being collected.
- (d): A total number of 114 cases pertaining to Disproportionate Assets to the known source of income are at different stages of investigation in CBI as on 30.06.2015.
- (e): The information forms part of individual case and is not maintained centrally by the CBI in this regard.
