- (c) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor?

(a) Length of national highways constructed by the National Highways Authority of India (NHA) during last three years under Build-Operate-Transfer (BOT) mode of delivery is as follows:

2013-14	1525
2014-15	1173

(b) and (c) No, Madam. However, three national highway projects having a length of 374.92 KM in the State of Kerala and two projects having length of 208.0 KM in the State of Goa are terminated/Letter of Award withdrawn/foreclosed due to issues related to land acquisition.
