- (e) the likely decline of export in percentage during the current cotton marketing year?

- (a) to (d): Yes Madam. The main reason for fall in exports from India include decline in imports by China and reported offloading of its huge reserves of cotton.
- (e): As per estimates by the Cotton Advisory Board, export are expected to decrease by around 41 to 70 lakh bales in comparison to 117.92 lakh bales in the previous cotton year.
