- (a) whether the textile industry is facing recession and is in a steady stage of decline and tailspin during the last few years;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (c) the reasons for large scale slump, lack of exports and pulling out by the top-notch textile manufacturers;
- (d) whether the Government is contemplating a comprehensive package to overcome the crisis prevailing in the textiles sector in the country including Bihar due to the global economic slowdown;
- (e) if so, the details thereof, State-wise; and
- (f) the action plan drawn up/being drawn up by the Government to tackle the loss of job opportunities due to this crisis?

(d) to (f): In order to increase the production and export, number of policy initiatives have been taken and schemes namely Technology Upgradation Fund Scheme (TUFS), Schemes for the development of the Power-loom Sector, Schemes for Technical textiles, Scheme for Integrated Textile Parks (SITP), Integrated Skill Development Scheme are being implemented in all States including Bihar.
