(a) to (c): The Ministry of Human Resource Development had introduced the Universities for Research & Innovation Bill 2012 in Lok Sabha on 21st May, 2012 after finalizing the concept. Some locations were tentatively identified.

However, with the dissolution of the 15th Lok Sabha, the Universities for Research & Innovation Bill 2012 has since lapsed.
