Will the Minister of TEXTILES be pleased to state:

- (a) the policy formulated by the Government for rehabilitation of the workers unemployed due to closure of the textile units;
- (b) whether the Government has taken any steps for taking help of National Institute of Fashion Technology (NIFT) to make adequate arrangements for imparting training to such unemployed workers; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF TEXTILES (SHRI SANTOSH KUMAR GANGWAR)

- (a) Government of India had introduced the Textile workers Rehabilitation Fund Scheme (TWRFS) with effect from 15-9-1986 to rehabilitate the Textile workers rendered un-employed as a consequence of permanent closure of textile units, in the private non-SSI Sector in the country. The scheme is not applicable to the State/Central Govt. Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) and the textile units in the co-operative fold of the State/ Central Govt. The objective of the TWRF Scheme is to give interim relief to the workers rendered jobless for a period of three years on a tapering basis, 75% of the wage equivalent in the first year, 50% in the second year and 25% in the third year. The mills closed on or after 05.06.1985 are covered under TWRFS.
- (b) There is no such proposal to train the unemployed workers of closed Textile units in the National Institute of Fashion Technology (NIFT).
