- (c) Under the Revival Scheme-08 based on Techno-Economic Viability studies conducted by various Textile Research Associations, approved by Board for Industrial and Financial Reconstruction (BIFR), National Textile Corporation Limited (NTC) has modernized 23 mills on its own at a cost of Rs.1585 crores and 5 mills revived through Joint Venture route.

After the NTC's net worth turned positive and discharged from the purview of Sick Industrial Companies Act (SICA)/BIFR, NTC is formulating fresh modernization/revival plan with the assistance of Northern India Textile Research Association (NITRA).
