(a) the criteria for setting up of the centres of National Institute of Fashion Technology (NIFT) in the country;

(b) the State-wise details of present centres of NIFT countrywide, including Rajasthan;

(c) the details of the amount spent on proper functioning and maintenance of the said centres during each of the last three years and the current year;

(d) whether any proposal regarding the setting up of more such centres in the country including Rajasthan is under consideration of the Union Government; and

(e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a): As per the policy regarding setting up of the NIFT Campuses in the country, the State Govt. seeking NIFT campus, is required commit the following conditions:-

• 20 acres land free of cost.

- Construction cost of campus.
- Cost of equipments, furniture and machines etc.

• Revenue losses, till the Campus becomes financially viable.

(b): There are 15 Centres of National Institute of Fashion Technology (NIFT) currently functioning in the country located at:-

(c): The funds spent for the smooth functioning and maintenance of NIFT's centres during the last three years and current year, Centrewise are annexed in the Annexure-"A".

(d) & (e): No new proposal regarding setting up of more NIFT Campuses in the country including Rajasthan is under consideration. Besides, as per the existing policy of NIFT, only one NIFT Campus can be opened in one State. A NIFT Campus is already operational at Jodhpur in Rajasthan.
