(a) & (b): Furnishing Aadhaar Numbers have not been made mandatory for Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) at the time of their registration in the country. However, the Ministry of Women and Child Development has instructed the NGOs who are being funded under various schemes of the Ministry to furnish Aadhaar Numbers of their main functionaries to facilitate processing of their cases for grants under the Schemes.
