- (a) whether the Government proposes to set up Yoga and Naturopathy hospitals in the country;
- (b) if so, the details and the location thereof, along with the time by which these are likely to be set up State/UT-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has included/proposes to include Yoga and Naturopathy in NRHM projects; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

(a) & (b): Under National AYUSH Mission(NAM), Government of India has provided Grants-in- aid during 2014-15 to the States of Andhra Pradesh, Manipur and West Bengal for setting up of 50 bedded integrated AYUSH hospitals which include Yoga and Naturopathy systems. The time-frame for the setting up of these projects has not been specified.

Further, Government has also approved construction of Central Research Institute for Yoga and Naturopathy (CRIYN) at Nagmangala (Karnataka), Jhajjar(Haryana) and Rohini(Delhi) with Indoor Patients(IPD) facilities.

(c) & (d): Under National Health Mission (NHM)/ National Rural Health Mission (NRHM), engagement of Ayurveda, Yoga & Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha and Homoeopathy (AYUSH) doctors/ paramedics is being supported by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India provided they are co-located with existing District Hospitals (DHs), Community Health Centres (CHCs) and Primary Health Centres (PHCs) with priority given to remote PHCs and CHCs.
