- (a) whether the Government has reduced the fund amount of assistance being provided to the States for the central schemes such as Indira AwasYojana, MGNREGA, PradhanMantri Gram SadakYojana, Rajiv Gandhi GrameenVidyutikaranYojana (RGGY) etc.;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the reduction has impacted the implementation of the said schemes and affects developmental works in States including Bihar; and
- (d) if so, the reaction of the Government in this regard?

(a)&(b): The details of the budgetary allocations of Indira Awaas Yojana (IAY), Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA), PradhanMantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY), Rajiv Gandhi Grameen Vidyutikaran Yojana (RGGVY) during 2014-15 and 2015-16 are as follows:

As per recommendations of the Fourteenth Finance Commission, the central devolution of funds has been increased from 32% to 42% of the net proceeds of sharable central taxes during the financial year 2015-16. During 2014-15, Stateshad been provided funds to the tune of Rs. 3.82 lakh crore and it has been increased up to 5.24 lakh crore during financial year 2015-16.

(c)&(d): In view of the greater devolution of central funds, the States including State of Bihar are expected to enhance their contribution underCentrally Sponsored Schemes (CSS) so that the developmental works in the States are not affected and the intended benefits of the schemes are maintained.
