- (e) the steps taken by the Government to promote, develop and step up gold and diamond exploration and production in the country? profitable?

STATEMENT REFERRED IN REPLY TO LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO.297 FOR REPLY ON 10.08.2015 REGARDING GOLD AND DIAMOND EXPLORATION ASKED BY SHRI RAGHAV LAKHANPAL AND SHRI FEROZE VARUN GANDHI

- (a) As per National Mineral Inventory prepared by Indian Bureau of Mines the State-wise reserves/resources of gold and diamond as on 01.04.2013 are given in Annexure-I (A) and I (B), respectively.
- (b) As per the available information with Indian Bureau of Mines, the quantity and value of gold and diamond produced in the country, during last three years and current year State/UT wise is given as Annexure-II.
- (c) & d) No such complaint has been received in this regard in the Ministry of Mines.
- (e) The scientific and detailed prospecting is carried out to establish mineral resources. A number of agencies like Geological Survey of India, Mineral Exploration Corporation Limited, State Directorate of Geology & Mining, State/Central Undertakings and private companies is engaged in exploration of mineral resources including gold and diamond.

MMDR (Amendment), Act 2015 has introduced the concept of prospecting licence-cum-mining lease (PL cum ML) for exploration and mining of deep seated minerals like gold and diamond. After doing preliminary exploration, States will auction PL cum ML. Easy transferability of PL cum ML has been provided in order to make it attractive to explorers.

As per MMDR (Amendment), Act 2015, National Mineral Exploration Trust (NMET) has been created to take up and accelerate mineral exploration in the country.
