- (a)& (b): India Tourism Development Corporation (ITDC) Ltd. is a Public Sector Undertaking of the Ministry of Tourism, Government of India and Hotel Corporation of India (HCI) Ltd. a Public Sector Undertaking of Ministry of Civil Aviation, Government of India. ITDC has signed Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Tripura Tourism Development Corporation Ltd. to form a Joint Venture Company for setting up a 3-Star Hotel at Agartala.
- (c): Statement showing State and City-wise details of owned hotels, managed and joint venture Hotels of ITDC are given in Annexure-I. Statement showing State and City-wise details of Hotels of HCI are given in Annexure-II.
- (d) & (e): ITDC Hotels follow the guidelines provided under Star classification by the Ministry of Tourism, Government of India.
