(a) to (c): Delhi Police does not have any plan to conduct DNA tests on people begging on the streets with children to find out if the kids are their own or have been abducted and trafficked. There is no provision in law to conduct DNA test on people begging on the streets with children to settle the paternity issue unless they are found involved in any criminal act associated with trafficking and kidnapping of children.
