(a) to (d): Recently, to maintain uniformity & transparency in procurement operations, the Government has formulated Price Support Scheme (PSS) guidelines in consultation with all stakeholders. Procurement under the PSS is undertaken on the request of State / UT Governments, who agree to exempt the procured commodities from levy of mandi tax and assist central agencies in logistic arrangements on reimbursement basis. Further, the stocks are purchased by Cooperative Societies, Farmers' Producer's Organisations (FPO), Farmers' Producer's companies, Panchayati Raj Institutions directly from genuine farmers having legitimate land record to eliminate possibility of middlemen taking advantage of the scheme. Further, the purchase centres are established close to the CWC / SWC godown, processing mill to reduce the transportation cost. The reporting of purchase is made through online mechanism and the central / state procuring agencies are required to display the details of purchases on a daily basis on their website.
