(a) Government has established the National Adaptation Fund on Climate Change (NAFCC) with a budget provision of Rs. 350 Crores for the year 2015-16 and 2016-17, with an estimated requirement of Rs. 181.5 Crores for financial year 2017-18. The National Bankfor Agriculture and Rural Development(NABARD)has been appointed as National Implementing Entity (NIE) under the NAFCC.
(b), (c)\& (d)NABARD has been accredited by Green Climate Fund (GCF) Board as one of the National Implementing Entity (NIE) for GCF in India.According to the GCF Board document, NABARD as one of the NIEsof the Green Climate Fund is responsible for management and oversight of project implementation, whichincludes the origination and preparation of a funding proposal, the subsequent management of thenecessary stages of the implementation process until its conclusion (project management) on behalf of GCF, and reporting obligations. Other institutions meeting the GCF requirements and standards have also applied for accreditation as NIE for GCF in India.
