(a) to (d) There are 18 Umbrella Schemes of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change under Central Sector (CS) and Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSS), implemented in the Country, inter alia, for environment protection. These Schemes are broadly covered under Environment, National River Conservation Plan, Forests & Wildlife, National Afforestation Eco-Development Board and Animal Welfare.
