As per the information furnished by University Grants Commission (UGC), the Commission has requested all the Universities/Institutions which are running distance education courses/programmes for submission of an affidavit from them to ensure abiding of all the terms & conditions as envisaged by it for the purpose of maintaining the standards and quality in imparting education through Open & Distance Learning (ODL) mode for continuation of the recognition of the various courses/programmes during the current academic session 2015-16.
- (d): The UGC has further stated that as soon as the affidavit is received from such Universities/Institutions, the same shall be processed on priority to avoid any inconvenience to the students for granting recognition to the various courses/programmes during the current academic session 2015-16. The names of the Universities/Institutions which have been given recognition for the academic year 2015-16 have been uploaded on UGC website (www.ugc.ac.in).
