- (c) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the measures being taken by the Government to increase the number of persons to visit abroad under the exchange programmes particularly in different cities and towns of the country?

(a) to (d): Educational Exchange Programmes (EEPs) entered into by this Ministry with foreign Governments are of over-arching nature that envisage to facilitate exchange of faculty and research scholars between India and the respective countries through collaborative arrangements between counterpart institutions in the two countries. The EEPs provide only a platform for such arrangements and the institutions are free to conclude specific arrangements for collaboration. Therefore, information in respect of visits by professors, scientists, researchers and educationists under such faculty exchange programmes undertaken by institutions is not maintained by this Ministry.
