- (b) if so, the details thereof during the last three years, State-wise?

(a) & (b): An announcement has been made in the Union Budget 2015-16, inter-alia, to upgrade Indian School of Mines, Dhanbad into a full-fledged Indian Institute of Technology (IIT). There is no proposal for upgradation of any other Institute as an NIT/IIT. In the last three years, only Institute of Technology (Banaras Hindu University) Varanasi has been converted into an IIT, the Indian Institute of Technology, (Banaras Hindu University), Varanasi. This was done on 20.06.2012 through the Institutes of Technology (Amendment) Act, 2012.
