Training by ITI

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

(a) whether a large number of students who have completed training from various Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) are waiting for Certificates from the National Council of Vocational Training (NCVT);

(b) if so, whether any steps are being taken by the Government to expedite the issue of certificates by the NCVT to the students who have completed the course;

(c) if so, the details thereof; and

(d) if not, the reason therefor?

Answer

(a) to (d) Students who complete training and pass the All India Trade Test are issued provisional certificates by State Directors immediately after declaration of result. NCVT certificates are issued to such students upon receipt of trainee details from the State Directorates.

Further, to expedite the process of issue of certificates, NCVT had decided to print the certificates directly in the name of trainees. Accordingly, 21,51,647 pending certificates has already been forwarded to State Directors for issue to the students between October, 2012 to October, 2014. Furthermore, considering the difficulties of ITI students, Government has also launched NCVT- MIS portal for issuance of e-Certificate to all students of ITIs. The students admitted to ITIs in August, 2014 and beyond have their details available on NCVT- MIS Portal and their e-certificates would be generated online through the portal once they have passed All India Trade Test. For the students admitted before August, 2014, State Governments have been requested to expeditiously forward the details of students after passing the exam, on a Compact Disc (CD) for early issuance of e-Certificates through NCVT-MIS portal.
