- (c) whether the proposed right will task State Governments with the responsibility of imparting vocational training through special universities;
- (d) if so, whether the Union Government will set up regulatory body to oversee the universities, colleges and institutes and integrate them to make result oriented; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof along with the other steps taken/being taken by the Government to boost skill development in the country?

Answer

- (a) Chhattisgarh is the first and the only State in the Country that has enacted 'Right of Youth to Skill Development Act'.
