(a) whether the Government has come to know that D.Y. Patil Institute has refused to admit 36 students in its colleges in Maharashtra, who have come back from Mauritius on account of derecognition of D.Y. Patil Medical College in Mauritius;

(b) if so, the details thereof along with the reasons for the said institute not admitting these students in its colleges in Maharashtra despite charging fees of Rs. 28 lakh from each of the said students for studying in the medical college in Mauritius;

(c) the details of the action taken by the Government against the said institute; and

(d) the action taken by the Government for getting these students admitted in medical colleges to save their future?
